Developing any software package or website requires very careful planning. In the case of a website you will always need to consider the following: Its purpose, the target audience, the navigation and links, the size of pictures and graphics, the overall look and ease of use.

During the second stage of this ELO you will be using your plan to create and develop your website.

It is expected that you develop good skills with a wide range of software including the following FrontPage 2002 or later, JASC Paint Shop Pro 8, and Animation Shop. A good website will always balance text, images, and other effects. It should be easy to use (navigate) and have a consistent appearance.

You should consider the following:

1. Have you successfully created a range of pages? For example, a navigation page (or frame), about me/my family, my interests,

- my favourite things, my pets, web links, my picture page, a bibliography. Do these pages balance text with pictures?
2. Are these pages easy to read and navigate? (Please try to avoid rainbow colours or animated backgrounds) The basic rule is dark text on a light background or light text on a dark background.
 3. Have you incorporated some of the following; an original graphic or other image? Mouse over effects, (a change of colour, image or tool tip) Does at least one page include background music
 4. A java applet, or plug in (Flash animation) You might find the free version of Mix Fx useful for this
 5. Are your colours and page designs consistent?
 6. Does at least one page include an animation? (preferably created by you using JASC or ULEAD software)
 7. Have you corrected errors or edited the html directly? For example you could add a title, change a colour, remove unwanted code or add an applet.
 8. Do your pages include a name tag?
